Westside Works is a long-term neighborhood program focused on creating employment opportunities and job training for residents of the Westside community, including Vine City, English Avenue, Castleberry Hill and other contiguous neighborhoods. Westside Works is a partnership among [Construction Education Foundation of Georgia \(CEFGA\)](#), [Integrity Community Development Corporation \(Integrity CDC\)](#) and the [Arthur M. Blank Family Foundation](#).

After a 4-week training program in construction, the inaugural class of Westside Works graduated on July 10, 2014. All 14 students were matched with jobs at construction projects throughout metro Atlanta including the New Atlanta Stadium, Coca-Cola Headquarters, State Farm Headquarters at Perimeter Mall and Porsche American Headquarters.
