Capital Good Fund:

\$1 million for the Georgia BRIGHT (Building Renewables, Investing for Green, Healthy, Thriving communities) pilot project, which uses innovative financing to lease rooftop solar systems to low- and moderate-income families in Georgia

Clean Grid Initiative:

\$6.1 million to support a collaborative philanthropic approach to expand transmission infrastructure in the U.S.

Southern Environmental Law Center (SELC):
\$2.5 million has to support its Clean Energy
Program, which focuses on increasing clean energy deployment in the Southeast
