Recent Grants

Affordable Housing

- Westside Future Fund (WFF):
 \$10 million to support WFF's Our Next
 Chapter campaign aimed at reaching its goal to establish 1,750 new units of affordable housing
- Atlanta Land Trust: \$753,000 to support the building of four permanently affordable single-family homes

Financial Inclusion

- Georgia Resilience & Opportunity Fund:
 \$6.2 million to support GRO's In Her Hands
 program, a project with partner GiveDirectly,
 to provide 200 female residents in the
 Westside with guaranteed income over
 three years to increase their financial
 stability and level the playing field for
 women, who are most likely to experience
 income inequity and financial insecurity
- CareerRise:

\$6.2 million for the Westside Works neighborhood-based workforce collaborative, which provides workforce development programs and services to residents in the Westside
