Recent Grants

Affordable Housing

- Westside Future Fund (WFF):
 \$10 million to support WFF's Our Next Chapter campaign aimed at reaching its goal to establish
 1,750 new units of affordable housing
- Atlanta Volunteer Lawyers Foundation (AVLF): \$340,000 to AVLF to support its Standing With Our Neighbors program, which supports Westside residents by preventing displacement and improving housing conditions

Financial Inclusion

Georgia Resilience & Opportunity Fund:

\$6.2 million to support GRO's In Her Hands program, a project with partner <u>GiveDirectly</u>, to provide 200 female residents in the Westside with guaranteed income over three years to increase their financial stability and level the playing field for women, who are most likely to experience income inequity and financial insecurity

CareerRise:

\$6.2 million for the Westside Works neighborhoodbased workforce collaborative, which provides workforce development programs and services to residents in the Westside
